Dear Members of the General Assembly:

The Office of the Attorney General is required pursuant to 410 ILCS 45/12.1 (P.A. 94-0879) to annually report to the General Assembly the number of lead poisoning cases that have been referred to the Office of the Attorney General by the Department of Public Health for enforcement due to violations of the Lead Poisoning Prevention Act (the "Act") or for failure to comply with a notice of deficiency and mitigation order pursuant to subsection (7) of Section 9 of the Act.

Please be advised that the Office of the Attorney General received no referrals under the Act from the Illinois Department of Public Health between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020.
